## Dear Friends

I like a good routine, especially before going to bed. It helps to re-assure me that perhaps I'm in control and that all is well in the world. But while a milky drink and a set bedtime can go a long way to steadying our nerves, especially after we've braved a viewing of the ten o'clock news, there is always something that can come our way to remind us that any semblance of our control is just an illusion.

The other night had a small reminder of this when I was awoken by the deep rumbling and spectacular light show of a passing thunderstorm. I was able to marvel at the pent-up energy that we find in our atmosphere after just a few days of warm weather. I marvelled at the immensity of God's creation, that it contains such raw and untameable energy. Then I became quite irritated that it had woken me up and that my careful preparation for bed had all been in vain!

Sometimes unwelcome interruptions happen in life too. Often things that seem just as random, just as beyond our control, and just as powerful, can take our ordered lives and shake them, sometimes profoundly. Yet a thunderstorm is just a thunderstorm and will soon be over, and an interruption, even a calamitous one, will also pass in one way or another. While it is natural to feel shaken, irritated, or even angry, it is important that we remember that interruptions are what life is made of. Without them life would be bland and controllable, not really life at all in fact. Let us remember we may live in a world that is far from perfect, but we have a God who wants us to live our lives to the full, loves us completely and who listens to us when we pray.

Also, while being woken up was an interruption that none of us would want, I was nonetheless delighted to see that, following the rain that accompanied the storm, the grass already appeared, just a little bit, greener. It seemed an apt reminder. With Every Blessing, **Mark**
