Readings for today: 2 Timothy 1 vs 1-14; Luke 17 vs 5-10



Dear Friends, This Sunday we celebrate Harvest. A time to remember, celebrate and come in thanksgiving, to our Creator God, for all His good gifts, the abundance of His generosity, His provision. A time to remember, and be thankful, for farmers and all who work so hard to keep us supplied with food and other necessities in life, and for any produce from our own gardens. This year has seen its difficulties, with the long, hot, dry summer, and we remember those who are in need. But we still have much to be thankful for.

I hope you may have seen our latest Churchyard Trail; there are 12 short readings from the Book of Psalms. This book covers so much of life, many different emotions, and situations. We will be looking at some of the Psalms in our new Home Groups, giving us the opportunity to explore some of the richness found in this book. The verses outside, around the church, are drawing together various themes. They reflect the season of Creationtide that we are presently in - from early September to Harvest - rejoicing in our loving Creator God and thinking of some of His wonderful works of Creation. And in that theme of praise, we are also reminded of our Music Festival, which we are currently enjoying. There are those whose situations are difficult. Through some verses in the Psalms, we are reminded of the help and presence of God, who knows all we are going through, who hears us when we call.

By using surplus and/or donated produce, the pantry can provide a shop at a far more affordable price.

All Saints Belgrave serve a mixed community on a regular basis, so please feel free to donate whatever you are able to. Both food pantries can also receive surplus vegetables from allotments.
