
## ST DENYS CHURCH EVINGTON BULLETIN Sunday 22nd January 2023 Third Sunday of Epiphany

We had moments of Epiphany, of revelation, on our recent Quiet Day at the Stable House. As we started our Walk with Wonder, we paused by a tree hoping for a bit of shelter from the rain - as I explained something of what Walk with Wonder is about. While standing there, I felt tapping behind me. I turned to find a branch just behind me; as I looked closely, I saw tiny buds on the branches - signs of new life, of Spring. Nearing the end of our Walk, we saw a beautiful rainbow - sign of God's promise; the sun came out, shining so brightly; a moment of glory. Moments of Epiphany, of revelation. Having our eyes open; being ready to see God in our world.

Also, being open to, aware of, answers to prayers. Maybe, sometimes, we need to be a bit more specific in our prayers. God wants us to talk to Him about anything and everything - sharing with Him our joys, sorrows, needs, concerns, worries. In our prayers, alongside our praise, our thanking God, recognising who He is; we may also come with our needs - for others, but also for ourselves. Jesus told us: 'Ask, and it shall be given to you' (Matthew 7); asking, in accordance with God's will. Then, being open to those answers to prayer - which may not be as we expect - but recognising them as they are revealed to us - and thanking God for the answers.

May we always be open to those Epiphany moments, of revelation, signs of God's presence and glory, in our daily lives.

Epiphany time. Wonder. Awe. Revelation. God is among us.
