Dear Friends, I am aware that a lot of people in church don't get to see the work that I regularly do as a lot of it takes place outside of the church building or during the week and not on a Sunday. Most of the congregation don't see when I am at the Cubs and Scouts, Cadets, in the schools or with the Toddler families or our young people on Fridays, but these are regular things that take place where I am able to share faith and the love of Christ with others outside of church services.

Writing a funding report recently I estimated that over the past year my ministry has reached around 650 people from these groups, and I think that might even be an underestimate. Mission is a huge part of being a Christian and should be a huge part of we do as a church, going out beyond the walls of the building to where the people are.

So, I wonder, what do you do when people don't see you or on other days during the week that are not a Sunday? How often do we talk about our faith with someone else? How often do we offer to pray for someone? As Christians we are all a part of the mission, Gods mission. After all, the reason that we come to church should be to be sent out to share the good news and make disciples of others, so if that is not our reason than I wonder what is? We are the lucky ones as we already know God's love, so let's share that news so that as many people as possible can be blessed by that knowledge too. **Sarah.**
