Readings for today: Exodus 17 vs 1-7; John 4 vs 5-42



Dear Friends,

How do you picture God? An almost impossible question to answer. But, thinking about how God looks to us - made a little easier if you think of some of His characteristics - was the start of the 2nd session of our Lent Course based around the book and film, 'The Shack'. Various pictures, images, thoughts were suggested - including, of course, having a beard - a quite traditional sort of image! But how can we even begin to imagine what God looks like? In 'The Shack', the three Persons of the Trinity are pictured in perhaps surprising ways - but I am not telling you how here, as you might like to read the book or watch the film for yourself, if you have not already done so! But I think most of those taking part in the Course, last Sunday evening, agreed that the portrayal of God, especially God the Father, although different and unexpected, was very helpful to them.

Whilst we cannot know what God actually looks like, we can understand something of what He is like from the Bible and through Jesus. It is about relationship; our having and building up a personal relationship with God, especially through prayer. Our spending time with Him, through prayer, talking with Him, listening to Him, bringing everything to Him in prayer. Nothing is too large or too small for Him to be involved in, interested in, because He cares for us, wants us to share our everyday life with Him. He does already know about everything that is going on in our lives, but He also wants us to talk to Him about it.

So, this Lent, may we all seek to build up our relationship with God, whether or not we are taking part in 'The Shack' Lent Course or using the 'Dust and Glory' booklet. That this season of Lent may be a time of deepening faith for us; of our drawing closer to our loving God, and coming to know Him more. **Geraldine**
