Dear Friends, this year, Mothering Sunday is going to be a little bit strange for me as it is the first year that I will not be seeing my Mum; she is currently in Antigua on holiday! As I was writing her Mother's Day card to hide in her luggage, I took the time to consider to the origins of Mothering Sunday.

Mothering Sunday dates back to the 16<sup>th</sup> Century when people were given time off by their employers to return to their families and 'mother' church to attend a special service. When I look back on my own journey of faith, I am fortunate to recall the very first time I walked into a church - I was 21 years old and needed some TLC after a very challenging few years. I was nervous as I opened the church door, having no idea if the people I would meet would be "normal"! I need not have worried as I very quickly felt loved and cared about - I believe that as a church we are great at welcoming new people, and so many have commented to me about the welcome they have received at St Denys. I wonder if you remember the very first time you entered a church, how did you feel?

We know from the bible that God is everywhere and in everything (Psalm 139 v7-12, Jeremiah 23 v24, Acts 17 v24, ...) so why are church numbers not increasing in the UK, and I wonder if there is anything, as God's people, we can do to help?

God has blessed us with gifts and fruits from the Holy Spirit to share with others, and so if the people who need to hear the gospel are not coming into our building, it's important that we try to share the good news and our gifts outside of the "church" walls.

I would encourage you over the coming weeks to ask God what gifts he would like you to use. Is he asking you to be more involved in church? This doesn't always mean you have to be doing something practical during the services, it could be helping financially, praying or sending a word of encouragement to someone. Maybe you could help offer pastoral care outside of the church, and if so, I would love to hear from you! Blessings, **Kimberley**
