Dear Friends, We have enjoyed visiting our local Botanic Gardens a few times recently. When we went, towards the end of April, we

saw that just beyond the fish pond, in the long border, in amongst the other plants, there were a lot of buds on tall stems. We were a bit intrigued as to what they were, but we would have to wait, to find out. We went to the gardens again, about 3 weeks ago; there were now so many of these buds, bigger and fatter, with a few just beginning to open; and the rest, sitting there, awaiting their time to burst into flower – we knew that it would not be long. We visited the gardens again, last Monday. The wait had been worthwhile! There was now a spectacular display, of tall, gorgeous allium flowers; the huge, beautiful globes of purple – and so many – hundreds of them. What a glorious display! And as you look closer, you see each 'globe' is made up of many little flowers. All the intricacy of detail, so lovingly designed and crafted by our Creator God.

The buds had been waiting to open; we had been waiting to see them. And the wait was definitely worth it.

And quite an appropriate time for that wait, with the wait between Ascension Day and Pentecost. That time of prayer and waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit, the gift of God for His people – for those first disciples, for the early Church, and for us today.

Following the joy and celebration of Pentecost, last Sunday, we look to celebrate again, this Sunday, as we think of the Holy Trinity, our one God, who invites us to join in the love shared between the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The invitation is open to us all. Let us not miss out but accept the invitation with thanksgiving. **Geraldine**
