Readings for Sunday: Romans 8 vs 26-end; Matthew 13.31-33; 44-52

Dear Friends, travelling by public transport to and from London as I do once or twice a week, for overnight stays to look after my father,

something I have been doing for four years or more despite how tiring it is, gives one time to pause and think! I enjoy observing people and the passing world outside of the train or coach including the countryside and pondering about life in general including my own schedule of tasks to complete, thinking, and worrying about family and loved ones and what is forthcoming in my life. It can be quite a therapeutic process too at times. Often on such journeys, I think about my own faith and wonder, even question, just how effective my discipleship of Christ is.

Recent bulletin letters have stressed the importance of taking time out to rest, think, pray and take refreshment just as Jesus did in his ministry – in other words, recharging one's batteries. How often in our lives do we heed this advice? Are we normally too busy and can we be bothered to prioritise what should be at the top of the list, namely putting ourselves in the best position, mentally and physically, to follow Christ faithfully and be a true disciple of Jesus? If we are honest, we all need to constantly re-assess our commitment to this goal.

In September through to the end of November, a golden opportunity for learning about and deepening one's faith and seeing how life and faith connect, will arise through the Journey in Faith (JiF) course at St. Denys. Held on Wednesday evenings in the parish centre, I strongly encourage those of you who wish to try to follow Christ a lot more closely, to sign up soon! Let's face it – all of us who call ourselves Christians should be willing to achieve just that! There is always room for improvement, whoever we are and whatever stage of our faith journey we are at.
