Dear Friends, this Sunday, we will be celebrating the Presentation of Christ in the Temple, or Candlemas, our last look back to Christmas before we turn towards Lent, leading to Holy Week, the Cross, and on to Easter.

Last Sunday morning, I spoke of all the praise there was, surrounding the birth of Jesus. So many people in the Christmas story - Mary, Elizabeth, the unborn John, the angels, the shepherds, Simeon - had their own song of praise. Everywhere, we see praise! And, as we think about it, so there should be! Jesus, God's Son, the long-awaited Messiah quietly entered our world. God among us, in human form. No wonder there was so much praise!

We are called to be people of praise, to worship God. He is worthy of our praise, worship, thanksgiving. Praising God is about coming before Him with true, heartfelt, praise; worship that comes from the heart. Praise and worship that are born out of thanksgiving.

Whatever our situation or circumstances, there are things for which we can praise and thank God. Sometimes, it is about having our eyes open; maybe taking time to stop and look, to wonder; perhaps allowing ourselves to see things differently. It may be music or art that leads us to praise; perhaps someone's words or actions. Often there will be something in creation that draws us closer to God.

Recently, there have been some beautiful days, frosty, with blue sky, sunshine, the frost glistening in the sun; beautiful sunsets. At this time of year, we see the trees in all their stark, majestic beauty, and if we look closely, we see new buds, already formed - the promise of new life. As we see God's blessings, all around us; as we become more aware of the abundance of His good gifts in our lives, may it encourage us to thank God, to praise and worship Him. May we become people whose daily lives are full of praise and thanksgiving. **Geraldine** 1


