Dear Friends, we are about to head into an important week in the church calendar, Holy Week! Are you ready for it? We will follow Jesus' journey from the last supper with His disciples on Maundy Thursday, to His death on the cross on Good Friday, through to His resurrection on Easter Day.

As we revisit these events over the coming week, we may experience a mix of emotions, including anger at Judas' betrayal of Jesus, sorrow and grief at Jesus' death and then an overwhelming joy at the resurrection. Not to mention gratefulness for the ultimate sacrifice that Jesus paid for the salvation of every one of us!

In everyday life we experience many emotions. The good news is that Jesus is by our side no matter what we are facing. Don't be afraid to share your emotions, thoughts, and feelings with Him and ask for His guidance along the way.

I recently helped with the local special needs school's visit to St Denys where we shared the story of Holy week with the children; I was tasked with explaining the events of Easter Day. I used a simple game of hide and seek to aid their understanding. Could the children find Jesus in the tomb? Well of course they couldn't - there was much dismay, much like how the women at the tomb must have felt, when the children couldn't find Jesus in the empty tomb. As the children left the tomb (a tent in this case) I pointed to a picture of Jesus and explained that He was alive! There was so much joy and excitement on the children's faces.

My hope and prayer over the coming week is that whatever the week may bring, you will come to Easter Sunday full of wonder, joy, and excitement like the children at Oaklands. I think we could learn a lot from them in how we express our excitement! So let us radiate God's joy this Easter time.
