Readings for Sunday: Ephesians 1 vs 3-14; Mark 6 vs 14-29

Dear Friends

Charlie Brown famously said, "Goodbye always makes my throat hurt!" Saying goodbye is certainly painful and I know Sunday is going to be an emotional and difficult day, but I was so encouraged by Mark's words last Sunday when he said that we should think of my departure less as a loss and more as a sending out.

In the book of Acts chapter 20 we read about Paul's final farewell to the elders from the church in Ephesus. As I wrestle with what to say in my last sermon, I know I can't match Paul's mix of warning and promise all wrapped up in Christian love. There is understandably a lot of hugging and weeping and praying as he leaves them for Jerusalem, compelled by the Spirit and not knowing what might happen to him there (v22).

Paul's final words in verse 35 are a reminder of Jesus's own: "It is more blessed to give than to receive." I have received so much from you over the past 12 years, and I can only stand on the brink of this new adventure because of the experiences, the love and support, that I have been given in Evington. I have been deeply moved by the number of people signing up for the bus to Chester where I will be "given away" to the Cathedral on 27th July.

You have given me so much and my prayer for you is that you will continue to be blessed and be a blessing to those in need and to all who are part of our wonderfully diverse community. In the words of another of my favourite fictional characters, Winnie the Pooh, "How lucky am I to have something that makes saying goodbye so hard."

fizz will follow as well as music from a live band made


