Dear Friends, Safeguarding Sunday will be celebrated with deep thought of what I do silently behind the scenes either in church or at home. The Diocesan Safeguarding Team are looking to help people move out of danger, and work with their wishes of how they want the help which is needed to do so.

23 years have passed since Safeguarding started in 2001, just for child protection only. Since then, it has grown to include vulnerable adults too, and my workload involves keeping up to date with the changes that are coming too fast, but with praying and God's help, I have the guidance to continue this work.

God chose me for this position because deep down, I had a secret from my childhood which I could relate to, although this secret did not come out until 2014 when historic child abuse cases came to light, and this affected me in a number of ways; even my late husband David did not know until I came home from work on the Wednesday evening. I rarely told him to turn the television off, and when I did that night, he knew something had changed in my life.

Going on this journey, God walks with me, giving me a light to help a person within our church, and people I have helped have been grateful. All my work is confidential, and only the people know when I move the work to my Safeguarding Team in the Diocese, and Anthony gave me all the guidance that I needed to do this.

As you watch the television with programmes like Eastenders, Casualty and documentaries about domestic abuse, think about how they ask for help, it is not easy when you are not sure who to ask, and what would your answer be? The one that comes to my mind is contact the police if they are in immediate danger.

Over the time, there is a piece of the jigsaw that is missing, and until we can sort out help, it cannot be put in place. Only with God's help, guiding me to do this, can the jigsaw be completed. God Bless our Safe Church.


