Readings for today: Revelation 4; Luke 8 vs 22-25

Dear Friends. Some of you may remember that, quite a few years ago, we had a monthly magazine rather than our current weekly bulletin. In that magazine, we used to have a prayer focus, and I thought it might be good to have one again sometimes, for if you would like to use it. So, this week, you will find a prayer focus in this bulletin.

In chapter 4 and verses 4-7 of his letter to the Philippians, St Paul was encouraging them, in their prayers, that as they asked, they also gave thanks, telling them that God did not want them to worry about things, but to take them to Him, and to know His peace. And those words echo down the ages to us; words and encouragement that are just as relevant to us, today. Prayer is not just about coming to God with a 'shopping list' of requests. Rather, as well as asking God about those things that are needed, it is also important to come to Him with thanksgiving.

Prayer and thanksgiving should be about anything and everything. Nothing is too big, small or difficult for God. He longs for us to include Him in every aspect of our lives – the everyday things as well as times of great sorrow or joy. God is our loving heavenly Father. Just as human parents usually love and care a great deal about their children, so God love and cares about us – only more so; more than any human can; God's love and care for us are perfect; He is completely faithful, always with us, never lets us down. God knows everything about us, but He still likes us to talk to Him, share with

Him, about things – anything, everything. Talking with God, sharing with Him, listening to Him, is all part of prayer.

May prayer, including thanksgiving, be part of our everyday lives, and may we be aware of His peace. **Geraldine.**
