

Everyone on the current roll will receive a letter and an application form. The forms should be returned to Elizabeth Rudge at the church by <u>Thursday 3rd April at the latest</u>. Please note that this is a <u>NEW</u> earlier deadline, a change from that published last week!

Applications received after that date will not be entered on the new roll until after the Annual Parochial Church Meeting on 1st May.
