Readings for today: Galatians 5 v 1, 13-25; Luke 9 vs 51-end

Dear Friends. One of my favourite hymns is: 'I heard the voice of Jesus say...' The opening words of this hymn reflect the invitation of Jesus to us, to come to him with those things that weigh us down - our burdens, worries, cares, whatever they may be – as we read at the end of chapter 11 of St Matthew's Gospel. We do not sing this hymn very often, but I do sometimes hear the piece of music that incudes this hymn tune, on the radio; always a delight to hear. A while ago, going through a difficult time, so often when I was in the car, I heard this piece of music playing! God is so good.

I have heard a reminder, a few times recently, that music is good for us. Listening to music; being involved in music in some way; is good for our wellbeing. At the moment, that hymn, and those verses from St Matthew's Gospel, keep coming into my mind. And I think it is important that we take the words of Jesus seriously. When Jesus says to come to him and rest, we should do just that. It is a promise he made, and he told us to learn from him.

Coming to Jesus, resting in him, may all be part of drawing closer to him, allowing our relationship with him, with God, to be built up more. It may include more time in prayer – listening to, and talking with, God – it may include taking more time to walk; to enjoy the beauty of God's creation all around us. We need to be guided by Him, as to how our relationship is to grow and develop.

May we take time to be with God, with Jesus. He loves us so much.
