Readings for 24th: Hebrews 12 vs 18-end; Luke 13 vs 10-17

Dear Friends

The word family suggests different things to different people and brings out a lot of varied emotions. For many people family is a very important part of their life, for others it is painful to think about family members who have died; for some the baby they so much wished for never arrived or died very young; some have no close family or no family at all; in some families there are problems caused by mental illness or ongoing disabilities causing stress and worry; and in some families there are longstanding disagreements which cannot be resolved.

In the Bible we read about many families. Some, like the brothers Cain and Abel filled with jealousy and finally murder, and others like the story of Ruth and Naomi filled with loyalty and love. In the New Testament Jesus calls brothers to follow him. We read of Zebedee's sons Simon and Andrew being called, and then James and his brother John following Jesus. We also read about the family of Mary, Martha and Lazarus who were friends of Jesus and featured closely in His life.

At St Denys we have a Church family who are as varied as any group, but united in our love of God and our wish to worship and pray together. Among our family are older people, younger people, people newer to St Denys and people who have been coming for a long time. We all need to be nourished by coming together to listen to Bible readings, to be taught and to be led in prayer. We also need to nourish each other by talking and listening to each other, by encouraging each other and by praying for each other.
