*Readings for 10am: Ephesians 1 vs 11-end; Luke 6 vs 20-31*

Dear Friends, We have a lot to be thankful to God for at St. Denys! In addition to a friendly and strong Lay Team supported by volunteers, working together to run the church whilst in vacancy, I have been encouraged that I have managed to find clergy cover (except for a couple of occasions or so when worship has been Lay led) for every Sunday and Thursday morning service, and monthly Evensong, since Revds Anthony and Mark left us.

In just recent times, we have had several joyful events and services: In September, we witnessed the christening of Baby Sinklair by Revd Cecilia Adjadjie. Sinklair was so well behaved, taking in all around him and he loved Revd Cecilia – the feeling was mutual. Rather cute to see! In September, we invited the Intercultural Worship Ministry Team (Jessie Tang and her colleague Michael) to lead us in worship for the second time. Kimberley Tyler, our Pastoral Warden, was Commissioned as a 'Locally Authorised Minister' last month during the Harvest Holy Communion service, The parish harvest lunch that followed was enjoyed by those able to attend. Leicester Cathedral Choir and organist David Cowen, came to sing full choral Evensong.

Our work with local schools continues. Avanti Fields donated much of the non-perishable goods we received for our harvest festival—thanks to all who did donate! School visits are happening now and more are booked in for this year and Easter to come! We will have our annual All Souls service this coming Sunday. Wreath making workshops take place at the end of November, and I am planning a simple 9 Lessons and Carols service for Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> December. A Christmas Tree Festival is planned for the second weekend in December and two concerts in November and December—and much more!

As we organise and hold these different activities and services, let us never forget that in all we do, we should do it to the praise and glory of God, our Lord and Saviour. That should be the single most important reason above everything else. We should proclaim the gospel and bring others to know Christ in all that we do and say. Hold that as your inspiration!
